

DUCK MAZE ACTIVITY (EMPATHY)

Description:

Students will learn about empathy and solve a maze.
This activity can be done in class or at home.

Recommended Grades:

- K-2

Materials/Resources:

- Duck Maze Handout
- Pencil

Objectives:

Students will be able to:

- Understand what empathy means.
- Describe how being lost can feel.
- Solve a maze.

At-Home Use:

Describe the activity to the child.

Parent/Caregiver Directions:

1. Have the child to log into Capstone and go to the article, [Empathy/Empatía](#) in Pebble Go.
2. Listen to or read the article. Explain what the illustrations show.
3. Next, open the book, [Lost in the Maze](#), in Capstone Interactive. [Type Maze in the search box and press the Enter key.]
4. Listen to or read the eBook.
5. Ask the child to describe how Lea feels about getting lost in the maze.
6. Give the child the maze handout.
7. Present the following information and ask the child to help the baby duck.
 - a. This duckling has gotten lost and misses his family back at the pond.
 - b. Help this baby duck find the pond through the maze.
 - c. You can start either at the maze entrance or at the pond.
