

Description:

Students will explore the jobs of community helpers. This activity can be done in school or at home.

Recommended Grades:

- K-2

Materials/Resources:

- Community Helpers Handout, Pencil

Objectives:

Students will:

- Match hats to 6 different community helpers;
- Explore the jobs of community helpers.



Classroom Use:

Discuss the activity with the student. In many jobs, workers wear special hats. Use clues in the Pebble Go articles to help match the hats to the name of the worker.

Teacher Directions:

Introduce jobs in the community. Discuss examples like teacher, farmer, and/or police officer.

1. Pass out the Community Helpers handout and instruct the students to draw a line from the hat to the name of job. Provide assistance as needed.
2. Encourage students to explore one or more of the six community helper jobs by listening to or reading the Pebble Go articles listed below.

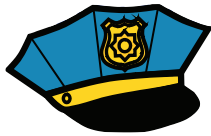

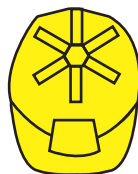
